### PRE-TASK

1. You are going to make a survey among your potential blog readers – your groupmates or friends or family members – not less than 7 people.

The survey let you find out:

- who can be reading your blog (age, sex, location, interests, etc.)
- what content people would like to see more of

Think about some questions – not less than 7 (not many more). Do not think too much, the questions can be very simple or sophisticated, or even humorous.

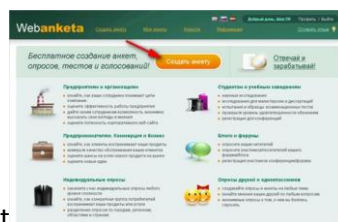

## TASK

XMind is the most popular mind mapping tool. Millions of people use XMind to clarify thinking, manage complex information, run brainstorming and get work organized.

1. Search for XMind from your browser. You will easily find **XMind Ltd** official site.
2. Download and set up<sup>2</sup> either XMind or Mindjet Manager for free.
3. Study the features of the program either in theory from the section Features of the site or from practice.
4. Create your mind-map on the theme of your blog.
5. Integrate it into your blog.
