PRE-TASK

Read about completely free Bolide® Slideshow Creator at <http://slideshow-creator.com/rus/>

Using the program, you can drop many photos to the timeline, tell the program to add transition effects automatically and save your slideshow as a video file.

Download the program.

TASK 1

Step 1. Take photos you want to make into a clip, and decide upon the order in which they appear in the slideshow – that's important. No big deal – just drag and drop them in the right field.

Step 2. Choose proper music to show the atmosphere of the event.

Step 3. Adding transitional effects – there are hundreds of them (you can preview each effect before adding).

Step 4. Thinking of and adding text comments to the photos. Be imaginative!

Step 5. Choose the output file format and quality and hit the "Go" button.

4. Insert your slideshow into your blog. If you need some tips how to do it, search for a tutorial or instructions.

TASK 2¹


You may add logo on video to prevent others from using it for commercial purposes. Furthermore, this will also let those who watch the video know that you are the creator. There are different programs that you can use to add a logo on your videos and here are some of them. Choose any you like.

– VIDEO GRABBER

Use [Video Grabber](#) online.

Since it comes with an intuitive interface, you can add logo to video easily.

1. go to the site of Video Grabber and then click “Convert” tab.
2. press “Select files to convert” button to browse your local video.
3. click Edit button to activate video editor.
4. click “Watermark File” option to load your logo picture from your disk.
5. press OK button to finish editing and then click “Convert” button to get start.

– VLC MEDIA PLAYER

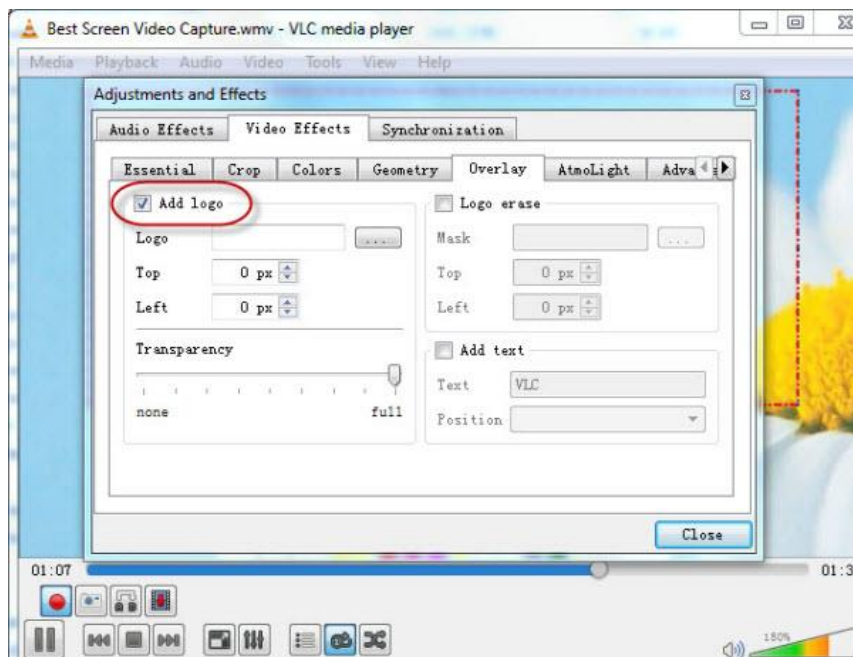
If you do not have VLC MEDIA PLAYER installed on your PC, you can download it for free at <https://www.videolan.org/vlc/>

You need to have the logo uploaded online as its URL is needed to add it on the video.

1. open VLC and play your video.
2. click on the tools menu, then select on the Effects and Filters tab. A new window should appear.

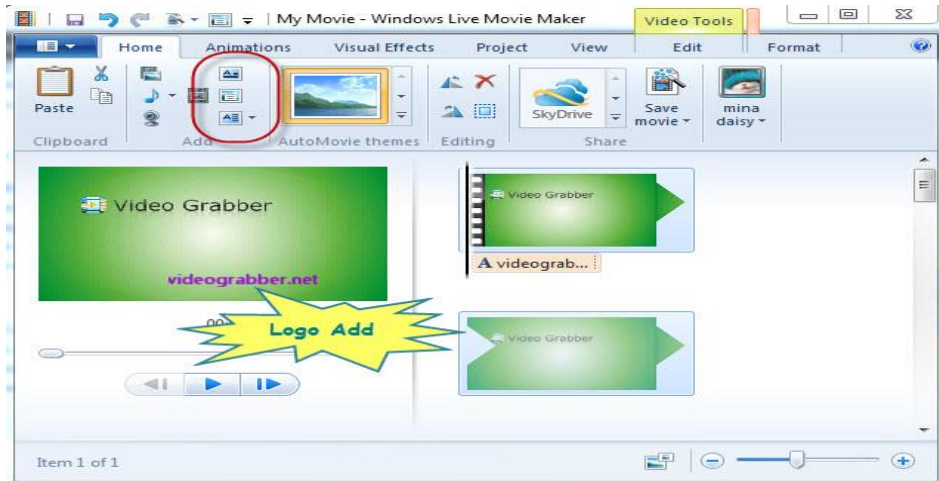
3. on that window, click on the video effects tab and search for the logo section by clicking on the left or right arrow.
4. click on add logo and paste the URL of your logo on the appropriate box.
5. adjust its transparency and position base on your preference and close. You should now have the logo on your video.



– WINDOWS LIVE MOVIE MAKER

Windows Live Moviemaker is a video editing software from Microsoft. If you have this installed on your computer, you can also use it to add watermark in video.

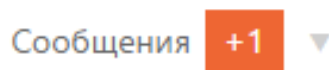
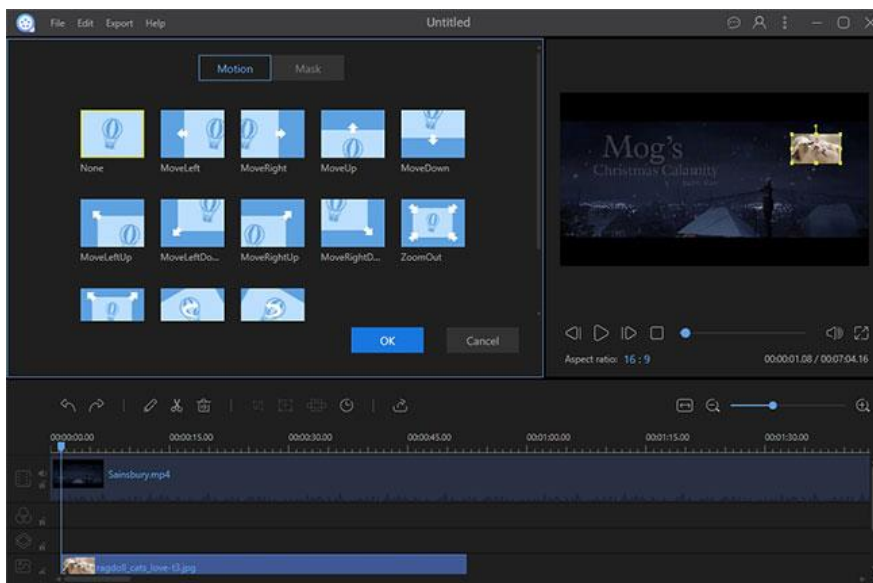
1. open the program and select the video that you wish to edit. On the home tab, click title.
2. type the text that you wish to appear on the video, which will serve as your logo.
3. change the font style, color and size of the text to the one you prefer.
4. move the text to where you want it to appear on the screen. The frame for the title will be on the first part of all the frames.
5. drag it throughout the frames of the video where you wish it to appear. If you want it to appear on the entire video, under the format tab, change the text duration to the total length of the video.



– A POWER EDIT

This is another program that you can use to add logo or watermark on your video. This is easy to use as it supports drag and drop. Download that from https://download.cnet.com/Power-Edit/3000-2352_4-31768.html

1. open the program and then drag the video file and logo picture into it.
2. right click the video and then choose “Add to Project”.
3. drag the picture to image track.
4. double click the picture track and then adjust the duration, size, position, motion and mask for it.
5. go to “Export” > “Export to video” to generate your work.
